Mrs. Betty Joyce McCurdy Ingram was called to her heavenly home on Sunday, December 24, 2017 at Piedmont Health Care Center. Betty was born Tuesday, July 7, 1931 to Lonnie Augustus and Julia Beatrice Stephens McCurdy in Piedmont, Alabama. Raised in Ball Hornet with 'Little Titter' Carol Jo and 'Bubba' Lonnie, Betty graduated from Jacksonville High School in 1948. Betty met the 'love of her life' George Russell Ingram, Jr. at Piedmont Springs Congregational Holiness Church (CHC) Campgrounds which lead to their marriage on Friday, March 10, 1950.
