



## Billy Olan Brown

September 17, 1932 - November 28, 2024

Billy Olan Brown was born in Rabbit Town, Calhoun County, Alabama in September of 1932. Last Thursday night, November 28, 2024, he continued his eternal journey, stepping into heaven at the age of 92. He is survived by his second wife Yvonne Brown; his daughter and son-in-law Laura and Wade Taylor of Alvarado, Tx; his son and daughter-in-law David and Susan Brown of Gainesville, Ga; two granddaughters, Brindley Taylor Panzo and Joanna Taylor Rawlings; two great granddaughters Addie and Avery Rawlings; two stepdaughters, Pam Cline and Donna Bradley; two brothers Garry and Larry Brown; and many nieces and nephews. He was preceded in death by his first wife Margarite Brown, his parents Loys and Frances Brown, and his sister Sarah Morgan. Bill, as most people called him, served in the Navy and then attended Jacksonville State University where he met Margarite White Brown. They were married for 46 years before her death in 2004. He was employed for many years in the computer field for Lockheed and then Unisys (formally Univac) until his retirement. He earned his master's degree in mathematics from Georgia Tech to further his career. Bill became a Christian shortly after his marriage to Margarite and served as a deacon and with various church committees at King Springs Baptist Church and later at Norton Park Baptist, both in Smyrna, Ga. He was a true servant of the Lord, both in his church and neighborhoods, and honored the Lord in all areas of his life.
