“ I want to say I am sorry for your loss to the whole Floyd family. Bobbie was one of the most God fearing women I have ever known and I am grateful to have known her. My son was in a terrible wreck in 2003 and was in ICU at UAB hospital and in a coma. On the 9th day, I was at one of my very short allowed visits and the phone rang in the room. The nurse handed me the phone with a shocked look on her face and said, "It's for you". It was Bobbie. She said, "Sherry, we just completed our prayer circle and God said, your son is going to be just fine." I felt the Holy Spirit go thru me at that very second and I thanked her thru my tears and gave the phone back. Then thru the ventilator tube my son said, "Mama, who are you talking to?" Doctors and nurses started pouring into the room from every direction frantically. The nurse pulled me to the side and said that woman called on the doctor's phone and it's just physically not possible for her to get patched thru that private restricted line...I have always known that I witnessed one of God's miracles thru the prayer circle of Bobbie Floyd that day. Thanks to her dedication and obedience to God, my son lived thru a terrible accident and has no repercussions from it even to this day. I know Bobbie has a special place in Heaven and I am praying for her family just like she did for mine. God Bless all of you and I thank her from the bottom of my heart forever. 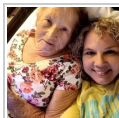

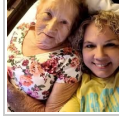
