May 31, 1935 - March 22, 2018

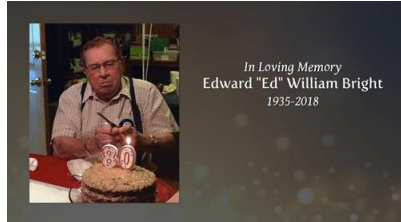
