She was a faithful member of Grace Tabernacle Church and always tried to watch the church service online after she became unable to attend in-person. She is survived by her son, Elisha "Eli" Conn (Penny); grandchildren, Laney Conn, Maddyn Conn, and Sawyer Conn; sister Dovie Heaton Bergin; several nieces and nephews, and special nephew Roger Wingard. 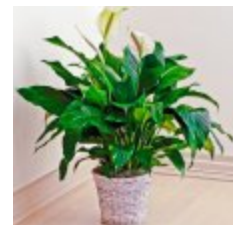
