Graveside services with military honors for Reginald Eugene Buttram, 83, of Piedmont will be Saturday, October 02, 2021 at 3:00 p.m. at Philadelphia Baptist Church Cemetery with the Rev. Rodney Ragsdale officiating and Thompson Funeral Home in charge of arrangements. Mr. Buttram passed away Tuesday, September 28, 2021 at his home. Survivors include one son, Darryl Buttram (Lynn) of Piedmont and one daughter, Helen Buttram of Mobile. Mr. Buttram was known as “Reg” to all of his friends. He attended Jacksonville State University and Trinity Missionary Baptist Church. Reg retired from Goodyear Tire and Rubber Company as a Senior Industrial Engineer and retired with 36 years of service with the Alabama National Guard in Piedmont. He was a proud survivor of prostate cancer, had been a longtime cattle and crop farmer, and enjoyed working around the farm. He was active in the Alabama Farmers Federation and had a great love of agriculture. He enjoyed going to Calhoun Farmers Co-Op in Piedmont to drink coffee and fellowship. Reg had been a patient at UAB and had undergone valve replacement. The family extends a sincere appreciation to Dr. Gregory Von Mering , his primary M.D. during this time. Reg was preceded in death by his parents, Thurston and Audrey Buttram; and sister, Glenda Buttram Morgan.
