Funeral service for MSGT Rev. Charles Stanley Wright, US Air Force (Ret.), 77, of Jacksonville will be Monday, September 28, 2020 at Plainview Congregational Holiness Church with Rev. Wright's son, Rev. Greg Wright and the Rev. Gregg Thurman officiating and Thompson Funeral Home in charge of arrangements. Burial will follow at Maple Grove Cemetery with full military honors. The family will receive friends Monday from noon until time of service at the church. Rev. Wright passed away Wednesday, September 23, 2020 at Riverview Regional Medical Center in Gadsden. Pallbearers will be family and friends. Honorary pallbearer will be Charles Jacob Wright. Rev. Wright was born in Piedmont and was raised in Weaver. He served as a pastor in Turkey and Germany as well as many area Congregational Holiness churches. He pastored Plainview Congregational Holiness Church for four years, Oxford Congregational Holiness Church for twenty four years and seven month and was the Superintendent of the South Alabama Region for five years. He served various duties while he was a pastor . He retired from the United States Air Force with 20 years and four months of service. Rev. Wright was preceded in death by his parents, Harold and Leona Wright and a brother, Harold Daniel Wright.

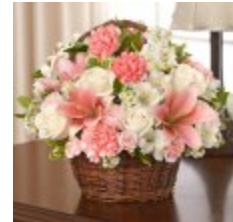
