Steven Wendell Renfroe was born on September 10, 1963, in Virginia, and passed away on December 15, 2025. He lived in Hoover, Alabama, and leaves behind a life marked by deep love for his family, a strong work ethic, and a quiet strength that those closest to him knew well.

Steve shared 31 years of life with his wife, Amanda, including 28 years of marriage. Together they built a home filled with love, loyalty, and commitment. He was a devoted husband and a proud father who found his greatest joy in watching his children play sports, cheering them on from the sidelines, and being present in their lives. 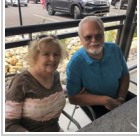
