A Memorial Service for Tony Wayne Rhinehart, 66, of Ft. Worth, Texas (formerly of Rock Run) will be Saturday, March 9, 2024, at Rock Run Baptist Church at 2:00 pm with Rev. Ricky Pollard officiating.
